

Our speaker for the evening was Mike Lovelace who, along with guest speaker Ron Van Kirk, provided an outstanding presentation on their experiences flying the OV-10 Bronco in Southeast Asia. I think everyone left the meeting with a real appreciation for awesome job these pilots did and the extreme danger they faced on every mission they flew during the Vietnam War. We will never know how many lives these unsung heroes saved both during the FAC missions and the SAR missions they flew but it is safe to say many soldiers on the ground and flyers who were shot down are still with us today because of their heroic efforts. Thanks Mike and Ron for stepping up to the plate and sharing your story with us. We certainly enjoy hearing first-hand accounts of experiences like this and I urge our other members with similar stories to please consider sharing those with us in the future.

Our March meeting speaker will be Terry "Ski" Slawinski who will be coming by to talk to us about formation flying. Ski is a retired Air Force F-16 pilot who now flies for Southwest Airlines.
