WARBIRD REPLICA becomes a WARBIRD.

A modified version of the Flying Legend Tucano Replica experimental kits have been contracted with the Dominican Republic Air Force. The modifications include wing and fuselage strengthening to

allow the aircraft to do +6/-3 g maneuvers up to the 1650 pound MTOW. It also has a larger fuel tank. The DR Air Force will use their technical personnel to complete quick build kits and the planes will used for pilot basic training and patrol. Flying Legend is also in the process of testing turbines as an additional engine choice for commercial and military customers.

Once I got the engine mounted, there are a plethora of things that can be done. I first worked the engine wire harness into the rest of the aircraft and tied most of that into place and finished installing the avionics. With a charger attached to the battery I powered the aircraft up. All good - except that the attitude/roll scale was upside down. I' not sure why having the ADAHRS upside down would invert the roll scale as well as the terrain shading, but it did. After flipping the ADAHRS over - everything was good. Even in the garage I can get GPS position and traffic targets. I haven't yet hooked up headphones to see if I can receive radio transmissions.

Next was several things that required sealant. I got the steps mounted, the gear leg seals and the firewall penetrations prepped, then mixed the Chem Seal and when to town.

I probably should have gone back and done the cowlings at that point - but I went ahead with the propeller and spinner. No big issue but I definitely noticed the difference between the prepunched CNC machined metal and the fiberglass parts that all have to be trimmed to size and fitted. and the spinner is an easy one to fit. Then to the cowlings, which required the spinner come off again. At this point the upper cowl is all aligned, drilled and cleco'd in place, waiting for the lower cowl to be fitted.
