## Editorial Notes by Larry Gordon

A good time was had by all, with everyone leaving with a fist full of unwrapped presents, smiles on faces, and so much broasted chicken was consumed that the next day the price of eggs went up \$1.00/doz! Thanks you to our Chapter elves for purchasing and wrapping "Ultralight Dice " prizes, and to all for contributing to the delectable luncheon buffet.

#### Lots of Cobwebs

January 31st, 2025 was a marginally nice day, with temps in the 30's and 40's, and winds NE at 10-12 mph. Having to do some things at the Wild Rose Airport, I decided to take some supplies and my flight bag to the hangar, just in case I had enough time to complete my mission and still get the Rans in the air for a

refresher flight. My previous attempt to fly was on a beautiful 50+ degree day following Christmas, only to be able to taxi the runways with a pair of non-functioning headsets. Duh!

After opening the hangar service door without finding anything amiss, I started to preheat the plane while doing my plane inspection. A double check of the rudder cables and tailwheel springs adjustments looked good, and the anti-rodent deterrent "Ajax" surrounding the tires was undisturbed. Oil level checked, gascolator sumped, tires pumped, and a "David White" headset plugged in and working. Check! Check! Check! Check!

Opening the hangar door and moving the plane out had me feeling confident that all was a go. I had even remembered to check my oil cooler baffle tape, and removed my exhaust pipe and carb filter winter covers, as noted on my seasonally revised checklist. Thinking I would run my pre-



taxi checklist as the engine oil was warming, I threw on the mags, master switch on, checked the throttle position, pulled out the choke, then turned on the ignition switch, only to hear the starter as it rotated the prop without firing the engine. Master switch off. Master switch on. The second attempt to fire up the engine yielded the same results. Master switch off!! Huh! There in my lap was my cockpit checklist and staring me in the face was "turn fuel switch ON"! So I did, and shortly after that the Rotax came to life.

The cross wind takeoff went well, but the plane seemed sluggish. All gauges were good, but the initial recognition of the effects of the dense air of winter, along with a 30 mph unanticipated increase in winds just above pattern altitude, was momentarily confusing. After checking out the neighborhood and brushing up on a few maneuvers to knock off a little rust,


