
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our library, those donations are welcome. See Ernie or Jerry if you would like to donate.

Board Meeting Minutes

11 February 2016

Meeting brought to order at 7:02 p.m. by Mark Gosselin.

Present were Mark Gosselin, Mark Pankratz, Ernie O'Roark, Doug Kelly and Jack Fromm.

Mark G. acknowledged Ernie for distributing copies of the current Chapter roster to the Board, including several new members who had signed up at the most recent membership meetings.

Next item on the agenda was the upcoming banquet. It looks like we have at least 29 people signed up so far, which exceeds our break-even number of 25 minimum. Mark P. said he would post a flyer at the hangar to inform people about the banquet and that non-members and latecomers are welcome – but that they should let Ernie know as soon as possible and that they can pay at the door. Mark reiterated that he's hoping we have a few people come early (around 5:15) to help set up and also volunteers to stay afterward to help straighten up. If we aren't able to do that, there will be a \$250 cleanup charge. The rest of the details about the menu, etc. will be posted in the newsletter.

The Boy Scout Camporee will be held April 16 and 17 and we will need volunteers to help kids with the rib-forming project station in the hangar. Mark G. said he got several volunteers to sign up at the February meeting but we could still use a few more, especially on Sunday. Those who can help are asked to bring ball-peen hammers if possible. Mark G. said Lin Caywood has offered to canvass some of her contacts who own certified aircraft to see if they are willing to offer flights but this might not be feasible because of the large number of scouts who will be participating. That is still to be decided. Mark P. volunteered to handle the insurance application.

Mark G. said preparations for the Tri-Motor visit are progressing. We have committee members already lined up for most duties. Mark still needs to speak with airport management as well as Steve Southworth at Landmark.

Mark G. and Ernie compared notes on how many people have signed up or paid for T-shirts already. We need to get at least 20 orders to get the \$20 price and we have about 13 so far. Mark G. said he approved an initial order of six shirts which we have already paid \$205 for. The Board approve ordering an additional 10 shirts to keep on hand for future sales and we decided to wait until after the banquet to place to order. That should give us enough time to allow those who weren't at the February meeting to decide if they'd like to sign up. While on the subject, Doug mentioned that we had offered door prizes or other giveaways at banquets in the past and he wondered if we would want to do that this year with T-shirts or other sponsored items. The vote was to postpone this until next year since it's probably too late to prepare for this year's banquet.

Ernie mentioned that while we can use the updated roster for the name tags for individual memberships, he was not sure how to handle the family membership names. Jack volunteered to create an on-line sign-up form both to make sure we have the names appear the way members want them as well as to poll the family members as to which family members they want tags for.

Meeting adjourned at 8:28 p.m.


