

**Young Eagles Report:** Matt- The June YE event used an expedited runner program to facilitate flying the maximum number of young eagles with the minimum of pilots. This program only can work if there is one chapter member per plane performing the necessary coordination of parents, young eagles and paper work for the pilot. Expect to go back to the regular routine in July pending availability of pilots. The new on line EAA process was discussed whereby parents can register without having to fill out the paperwork at the airport office the day of the event. This process will take some cleaning up to determine who prints out the authorization, parental and pilot sign off.

**Chapter Youth Involvement/Scholarships:** Matt suggested applications for scholarships won't ramp up until late summer. Anyone who has knowledge of such scholarships or applicants contact Tom Solar. Since the question of how does my child get to be a pilot is a complex one, Tom suggested the parent stay in contact with the pilots, chapter meetings, CAP; for the pilot path and economical routes, institutions, and mentors.
