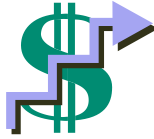

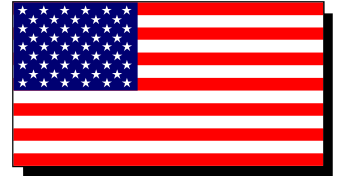
Tool Library
