Guadalupe St.. Continue west on Guadalupe St. thru the red light at intersection Roosevelt & Love St.. Continue to W. Grove St. turn left onto Grove continue to corner of Hull St. and Grove St.

Those folks coming from Sequin or Gonzales if you are on 123 continue Into downtown from intersection IH-35 and follow directions from IH-35. From Gonzales Hwy. 80 into San Marcos. At IH-35 go south remain on service rd. cross the San Marcos river and at next intersection (Hwy 123 and loop 82) turn right onto S. Guadalupe St. follow above directions from there.
