

It's only 16 nautical miles from HYI, but it's like going back 100 years to the beginning of flight. The Old Kingsbury Aerodrome (85TE) and Pioneer Flight Museum, house vintage and replica aircraft and accessories as well as restored cars, trucks, and motorcycles. Twice a year they have "Wings and Wheels" a fly-in and car show. The next event will be held on **November 11, 2023**. Once every month they invite volunteers to help maintain the grass runway, aircraft, vehicles and facilities.
