EAA Young Eagles Flight Plan

Following your Young Eagles flight, the Young Eagles Flight Plan will unlock a number of resources, designed to help you in your aviation journey.



1. Take a Young Eagles Flight

Young Eagles flights are available to youth ages 8-17, and are provided by EAA volunteers. Many flights are conducted at EAA chapter-hosted Young Eagles rallies, while other are provided on a one-off basis. Youths must complete a Young Eagles flight to access the other four steps of the Flight Plan. Find a flight in your local area today!

2. Get a FREE EAA Student Membership

An **EAA student membership** is available FREE of charge to any young person age 8-18 who has completed a Young Eagles flight. Student membership provides access to the same benefits and resources as regular EAA membership. Young Eagles can activate their student membership one of two ways.

- **Option 1** – When registering for a Young Eagles flight via **Young Eagles Online Registration**, youth can opt in for their membership.
- **Option 2** – Following a Young Eagles flight, youth can activate their membership by visiting **EAA.org/Student** and entering the unique code located on the back of the Young Eagles Logbook provided after the flight.
