camps were filled for this year and that applications for 2025 would open September 3rd, 2024. Chapters can reserve a spot and then provide camper information once a candidate has been selected.

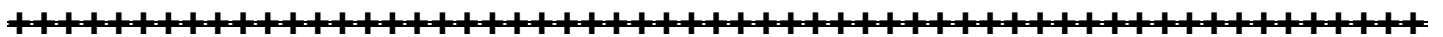
