The Grumman F6F Hellcat is an American carrier-based fighter aircraft of World War II. Designed to replace the earlier F4F Wildcat and to counter the Japanese Mitsubishi A6M Zero, it was the United States Navy's dominant fighter in the second half of the Pacific War, outdueling the faster Vought F4U Corsair, which had problems with carrier landings.



Airport update from Marshall Stevens Assistant Executive  
Director SARAA

Some old is gone. Something new is coming, and a major project is moving forward!

So what is missing? The NOTAM closing Runway 24 at night has been cancelled. Thanks to Andy and his team, we have been able to trim trees on the opposite side of Route 30 that have impacted the approach to the airport. As a result, W05 is now fully available for night operations (the Runway 6 approach was cleared last year). SARAA will continue to address trees and other obstructions around the airport on a regular basis.

A new hangar is coming later this spring. This is another private hangar to be constructed near the hangar that was built about two years ago. We continue to have interest in new hangar construction, and while existing infrastructure limits the capabilities currently at the airport, future projects should increase parking and hangar space at the airport.

As mentioned, we are moving forward with the project to construct a new apron on the south-east side of the runway. This is a multi-phase project to construct a new parking apron and provide the infrastructure for additional hangar development. We recently opened bids for the first phase of construction, which will cover the earthwork and drainage for this project, and we expect to receive funding and other approvals by early fall of 2021. It is likely that construction will begin in the spring of 2022. While the actual pavement for the apron is part of a later phase, we are excited to have this project progressing and will keep you updated as we move forward.


