family and that Santa brought you some cool aviation toys. Personally, I asked him to get my engine back from overhaul for Christmas. No such luck. 🕾




I hope you'll join us this Saturday as we kick off 2022. We'll talk about the year to come, Young Eagles, talk some safety topics, and catch up. See you there.


