EAA 1093 Board Meeting Minutes November 19, 2020

- President Fick declared a quorum present and called the meeting to order at 1702 EST. The Board meeting was held via Zoom.
- Directors in attendance: Dave Fick, Jeff Gallant, Sarah Haskett, John McPeak, Chris Pagano, Sarah Pagano, Paul Ries, Tom Ryden, Dick Sipp, Mike Woodley
- Directors unable to attend: John Haag, Pat Howe, John Sorg
- Guests: Don Bonem, Dot Hornsby, Brandon Marks, Jack Gavin, Carol Bogan
- Minutes from October 15, 2020, Board meeting were approved as submitted – motion by S. Pagano/Ryden
- Treasurer's report: none
- Membership Committee report: Chair Ryden reported no change in membership.
- Hangar Committee report: Chair Bonem reported that the reinspection of the hangars has been re-scheduled to Jan 4th, 2021. All noted violations have been or will be abated before the re-inspections, except for the 'excessive LP bottles' in the EAA hangar. Bonem provided the City

of Midland's LP Storage Requirements to the Chapter Facility Manager for resolution.

Chapter member Jason Braun has agreed to assume the Hangar Manager's duties upon appointment by the President. Bonem will remain available to help Jason/team to provide smooth transition.

Hangar maintenance: operator switch on 7B3 door was repaired; lighting in 7A and 7B hangars needs upgrade, replacement LED fixtures appear to be solution.

Hangar leases: Currently 7B3 and Yonkers are not leased and empty. Wait list parties have been contacted, no acceptance to date (Board requested no action on Yonkers lease). Cessna 150A N7131X parts still reside in hangar 7A2, door repair there is still pending. Since there are several hangars up for sale on the airport, Bonem anticipates that the Chapter will lose tenants as of January 1.

- Young Eagles report: Chair Gallant reported Kyle George flew five Young Eagles on Saturday, November 14. YE flights for December have been cancelled.
- Scholarship Committee report: Chair Jim Murphy submitted an e-mail

report. Each recipient of a 2020 Chapter scholarship has received an initial \$500 payment; none have yet submitted an interim report or requested a subsequent payment. The 2020 Ray Aviation Scholarship recipient, Daniel Libbey, is preparing to take his flight check before year-end.

Chapters may now apply for a 2021 Ray Aviation Scholarship (\$10,000 flight training grant) through January 31, 2021. When a Chapter is pre-qualified, nominees can be submitted by mid-March. Motion by Gallant/S. Pagano that the Board authorize **Chapter Scholarship Coordinator** Murphy to apply for a slot in the \$10,000 scholarship program – motion passed. Chair Murphy has suggested that the Board compile a list of possible nominees, as well as ask the Chapter members to suggest potential nominees to the Scholarship Committee.

The Nominating Committee reported that the presented slate of Officers and Directors for 2021 was elected via an online survey in early November.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

2021 budget discussions: Fick/S. Pagano – tabled until the December Board meeting.

Cessna 150A disposition: McPeak reported that 2 co-owners need to sign a Bill of Sale.

- RV-12 build project: S. Pagano reported that the build start is on hold due to restrictions on conditions for indoor gatherings.
- Building insurance coverage/waiver of liability: The Chapter has never filed a claim, and Ryden reported that agent Bone & Bailey suggests raising deductible from \$500 to \$2,500 per claim on policy carried by Granite State Insurance Co. to maintain the current level of premiums for increased coverage. Motion by Ryden/Gallant to authorize raising deductible to

\$2,500 per claim – motion passed. Ryden will coordinate with new Chapter Facility Manager and Hangar Manager before recommending to the Board any need for waiver of liability.

Building calendar use instructions: C. Pagano reported that instructions will be updated with 2021 Board at a later date.

NEW BUSINESS:

Online/proxy voting process: Motion by Ryden/Woodley to validate the e-mail votes of the Board members to authorize the use of an online survey to accept and record votes for the election of Chapter Officers and Directors in the absence of a November membership meeting – motion passed.

Leadership Training meeting: Motion by Gallant/Ries that the December 17 Board meeting also be the Leadership Transition meeting – motion passed.

President Fick adjourned the meeting at 1747 EST.
