President Sarah Pagano called the meeting to order at 1006 EDT.

Dick Sipp introduced Vic Syracuse (Vic), experimental aircraft builder extraordinaire. Vic presented a program about his experience in building Van's Aircraft RVs. He joined the meeting via Zoom, and the program was recorded. A copy may be available from President Pagano.

Vic detailed his history with building aircraft designed by Richard VanGrunsven (Dick), starting with his first build of an RV-4 when the kits were mostly raw materials which required the builder to fabricate almost every part. Working from pencil sketches and frequent conversations with Dick, Vic

eventually completed his first homebuilt, and has since built over a dozen others.

In response to a question, he opined that the time involved to complete an RV-12 build is at least 500 hours and averages 800 hours or so.

The meeting served as a 'kick-off' event leading to the Chapter's RV-12IS build starting soon. The first kits have been ordered and are expected to be on-site in April. President Pagano is keeping a list of interested participants, Chapter members should contact her to have one's name added to the list. Those folks will be kept informed re: dates/times/locations as the RV-12 build commences.

There were 14 Chapter members in attendance in the EAA Office, plus an additional 6 members who joined the meeting via Zoom.

Meeting adjourned at 1045 EDT.

Pancake Breakfast May 1st 2021

EAA 1093 Members -

At last month's board meeting the board discussed the possibility of a fully takeout pancake breakfast. This breakfast would be 100% take out serving pancakes, scrambled eggs, sausages and doughnuts. The grills will be set up far apart utilizing the entire hangar to ensure proper social distancing and those working at the same station will be from the same household. Food will be served in closeable styrofoam containers to keep them warm. We will be serving a set menu (ie: adult meal is 2 pancakes, 2 sausages, 2 scoops of scrambled eggs and a doughnut and a children's meal is 1 pancake, 2 sausages,1 scoop of scrambled eggs and a doughnut). The traffic flow will be up Barstow Drive, around the western driveway, past the EAA building and out the gravel road. So that those who come may still see aircraft I would ask that

members whose hangars are on the western side of the airport pull their aircraft out onto their ramps. We also discussed putting together take home goodie bags for the children and doing a live facebook video at the end of the breakfast to announce the 2021 scholarship award winners and possibly some aircraft taking off and/or landing.

I estimate the need for at least 15 volunteers to be able to make this happen.

While I know this is not the ideal way to run a breakfast and we will all miss the camaraderie of a normal breakfast I think that it is a good compromise between not holding a breakfast at all and doing a normal one which has its safety risks. This isn't about the income generated, it's about having an event and coming together in a safe way to share the Spirit of Aviation.

If you are interested in volunteering on Saturday, May 1 from 6:00am-12:00pm (breakfast will be served from 7-11 as normal) please let me know.

Minutes from February 18, 2021,

Board meeting were approved as submitted; motion by Gallant/Ries

Treasurer's report: Comerica debit cards have not yet been received. First purchase will be a subscription to QuickBooks.

A new scholarship account is being created at COMERICA.
