Despite there being a lot happening around the Tri Cities last weekend we had a decent turnout. We served a total of 337 meals: 281 adult and 56 child meals. After our expenses and credit card fees we have a gross profit of \$738.25. This does not include the return of unused product, so that number will go up slightly.

Overall, I see this as a success. It was certainly smaller than our usual breakfast but this was the first time having a drive through. The wind was gusty so very few planes came in, which is normally a big part of our sales. However, in my mind we achieved our goal: we held an event and shared the Spirit of Aviation with the community. I have had a lot of positive feedback from those who came to the breakfast. In addition, the unsold prepared food was taken to Open Door yesterday to help

feed our fellow community members who are down on their luck. We did a good thing for Chapter and our Community.

EAA 1093 Board Meeting Minute April 15, 2021

President Sarah Pagano declared a quorum present and called the meeting to order at 1700 EDT.

The Board meeting was held via Zoom.

Minutes from March 18, 2021, Board meeting were approved as submitted; motion by Gallant/Fick

Treasurer's report: Treasurer Marks reported that debit cards have not been received yet from COMERICA, so purchase of a subscription to QuickBooks is still pending.

A new scholarship account has been created at COMERICA. When signatures are in place, that account will be available and funded per the scholarship budget.

Online access to accounts at COMERICA is delayed yet again with other IT issues.

All bills are paid, deposits made, and reimbursements completed and up to date with the following account balances as of March 31, 2021:

Treasurer has requested access to hangar leases and list of tenants for data entry into QuickBooks.

Membership Committee report: Chair Ryden reported that current membership stands at 76 members. New members are Matthew Sape, Gaylen Sape, John McKeen, and Tobias Pobanz.

Hangar Committee report: S. Pagano reported that all open spaces in Cozy are spoken for, signed lease agreements are pending.

Letters will be sent to tenants whose lights have not yet been changed to find a time for them to move their airplanes so that we can change out the bulbs.

Don Bonem will report on repair of door for hangar 7A2 at May Board meeting.

Young Eagles report: Chair Gallant reported April YE flights were cancelled due to pandemic restrictions and May flights will also be cancelled. June 12 is Young Eagles Day, and Chapter 1093 is taking online registration for flights.

Scholarship Committee report: Chair Murphy reported that all of the monies for the 2020 scholarships have been disbursed.

The Committee currently has six 2021 applications and will meet on 4/20 to discuss scholarship awards, which will be announced at the May pancake breakfast.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

Cessna 150A disposition: McPeak reported FAA re-registration approval still pending.

RV-12 build project: S. Pagano reported on kick-off event during the March 20 membership meeting with guest speaker Vic Syracuse. The fastener kit and the empennage kit are being crated, with delivery expected by early May.

Build sessions will follow COVID-19 guidelines, and a build schedule will be created soon; members who want to be included on the list of builders should contact President Pagano. **Great Lakes Bay Invitational** fundraiser: Ryden reported that Chapter 1093 was selected as one of 33 non-profit organizations which will be assigned to two teams for the event. Organizations were selected based on their impact to STEM, Sustainability, Inclusion, and/or Innovation (Chapter 1093 was selected in the STEM category) The Chapter will receive a minimum of \$2,250 for each team (total, \$4,500) with the possibility of receiving more depending on the participation of the Chapter and the success of the golfer teams. Details on how the Chapter can participate in the July 11-17 event will follow.

Pancake Breakfast: President Pagano reported that a drive-thru pancake breakfast is scheduled for Saturday, May 1. The format will be take-out only (no interior seating) with customers staying in their vehicles through the process. The Annex will be used to cook the pancakes, eggs, sausages, and doughnuts which will be boxed and delivered to the customers in the parking area.

Set up and a dry run will be made on Friday afternoon/evening, April 30.

Microsoft 2020 Flight Simulator status: Chris Pagano reported that

the computer hardware/software has been installed and is operational. Documentation and instructions will be prepared and presented at a later date.
