TUBE COPING CALCULATOR

This is a handy tool for coping tube joints. I used it on a roll cage and it was a time saver. If you have multiple tube intersections you can print out a pattern for each tube and superimpose them to cut very complex end geometry. Just one more tool to solve the problem.


