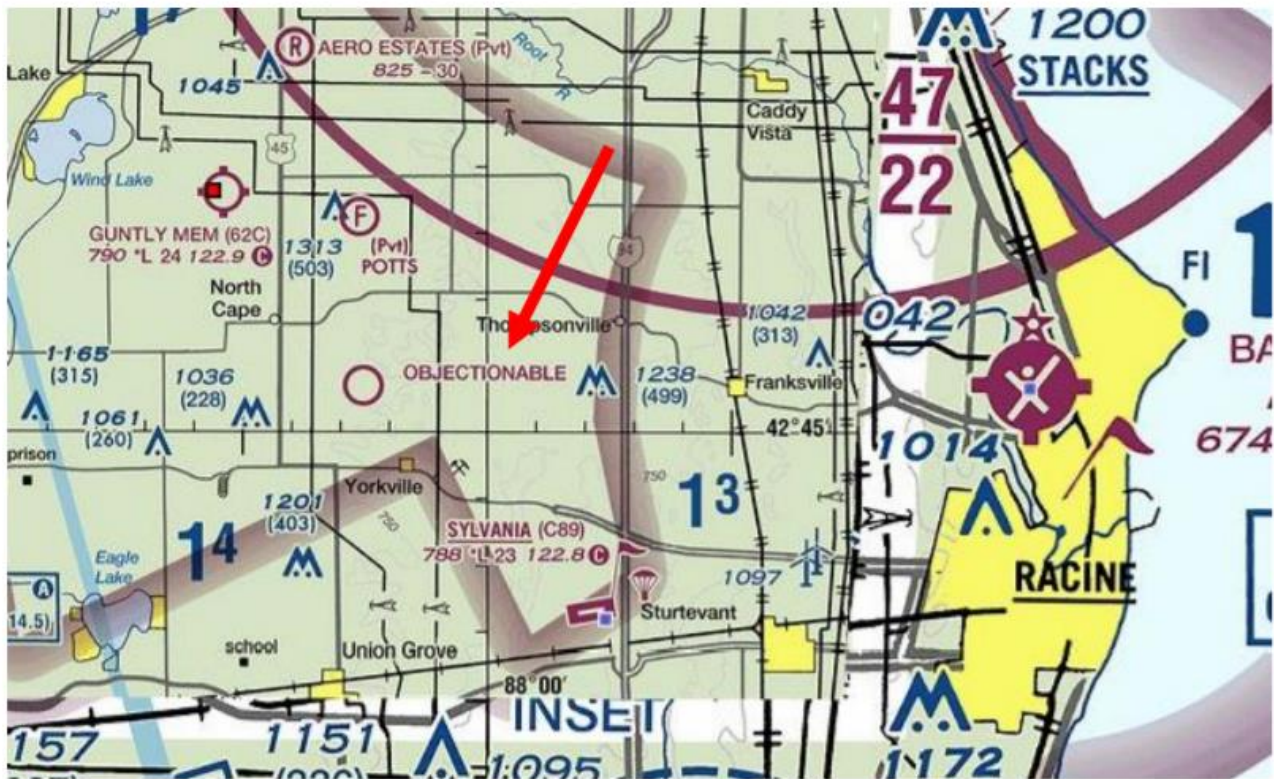
The July meeting for Chapter 1098 will be held at the Shawnee Airport, this Sunday at 2:30 PM.
