Dwayne Bell will be our speaker this month. He flew F-4s and F-16s for the Arkansas Air Guard for 20 years, flew 25 years for American Airlines, the last 15 years to Europe and Asia, and since retiring from the airlines early in 2011 has flown his Maule over 1000 hours.

On July 5th, 2021, last July, Dwayne and a friend departed from Arkansas and Louisiana on a flying trip to Honduras on an aviation, friendship, and mission adventure, flying a Maule MX7-235 4100 miles in just over a week. Come hear the pilot and aircraft owner tell about the adventure with pictures and answer your questions about flying in Central America, and the joy of aviation opportunities.



This is a bit off topic for an experimental aircraft club but, it does involve the FAA and experimentation.

With the FAA approval (finally) of launch activities at Boca Chica, Texas, SpaceX is very near (a month or two) making the first launch of Starship atop the Super Heavy Booster. This rocket will be the most powerful rocket ever made. The launch is guaranteed to be spectacular. It even has a chance of being successful.

Starship has already successfully completed, after a few attempts, high altitude tests to test the “belly flop” maneuver required for reentry, and the transition to a tail first attitude for landing, like the Falcon rocket.

Anyway, just a heads up for those of you who haven’t been following this closely. It’s exciting to me and I think it one the most important things happening these days. There are a lot of videos on various media sites of the progress of this project. Check them out.
