Joe has copy of EAA rules concerning events.


ATC radio traffic protocol Joe Hopwood has copies of Radio Protocols. Think about what you want to say then speak.

Next meeting is May 21-2022 at Rays Roost.


Joe Hopwood and Lewis Gaston said they will work May 21 event.
