On July 20, 2022 EAA Chapter 129 held its first Aviation STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics)


event at the Central Illinois Regional Airport. Nine students from the Bloomington/Normal and Champaign /Urbana area attended the event. The students were recruited from the Young Eagles event sponsored by the chapter on July 9th.

The event began with a classroom session titled "Introduction to Aviation" that covered the history of aviation, forces of flight and control surfaces. A tour of the airport followed with stops at the CIRA Control Tower, Fire Station and OSF Life Flight hanger. The participants were excited to view the landing of a 737 on runway 11 from the tower!

After the tour, the group returned to the EAA hanger for a discussion of different aircraft types and

aviation careers. This ended a fun and educational afternoon at the airport! Reviews from both students and parents were very positive!

The chapter plans on continuing the aviation STEM program in partnership with the area high schools and other interested groups in the fall. Chapter 129's YE Notes






