EAA's Ford Tri-Motor to visit Bloomington again April 29 to May 2

As part of our Chapter 129 initiatives for 2021 to introduce aviation to the local community, we requested a return visit of the EAA Ford Tri-Motor which was a big hit here in 2018. We were notified last week that BMI would be the first stop on this summer's tour of the US.

Our Chapter 129 member and United Airlines Captain, Bill Thacker, will bring the plane in on April 28 and will be our pilot during its stay from April 29 to May 2.

Synergy Flight Center has offered to hangar the Tri-Motor at their big hangar behind the Prairie

Aviation Museum and we will hold our event there also.

Thursday, April 29 will be VIP and Press day, offering tours and rides from 2 to 3 pm. Tickets for the general public will be available from 3 to 5 that day.
