6 PM Burgers on the grill – donations accepted

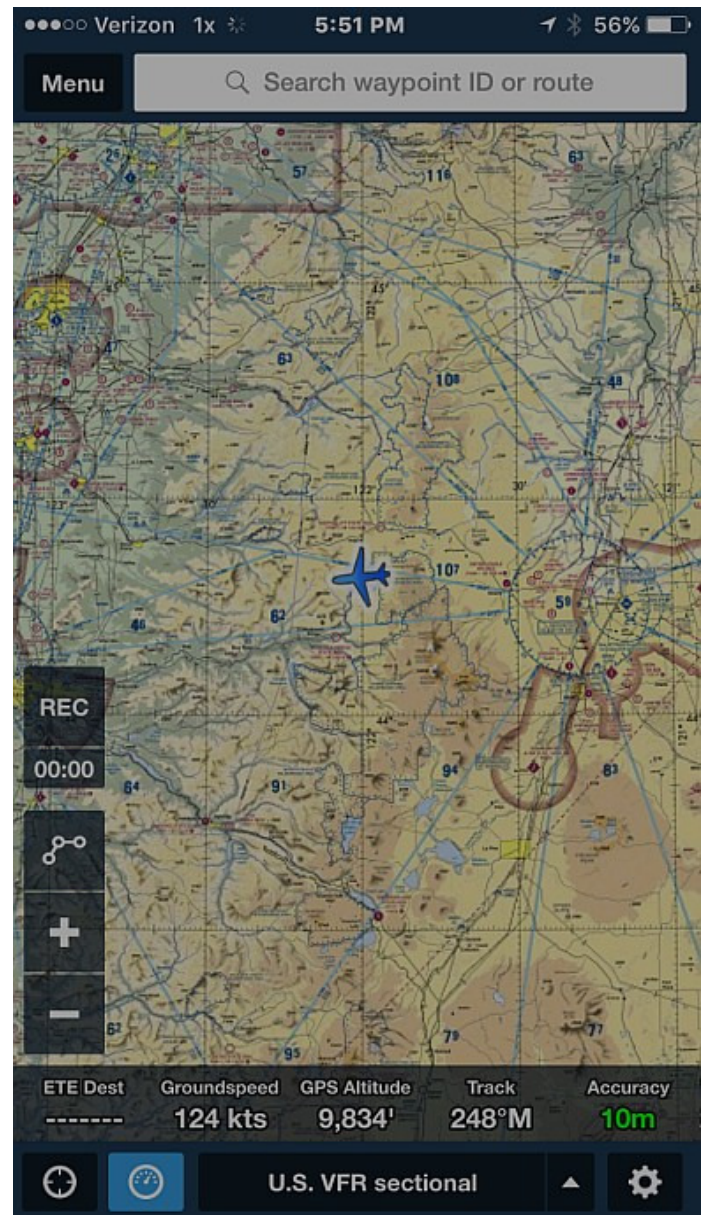
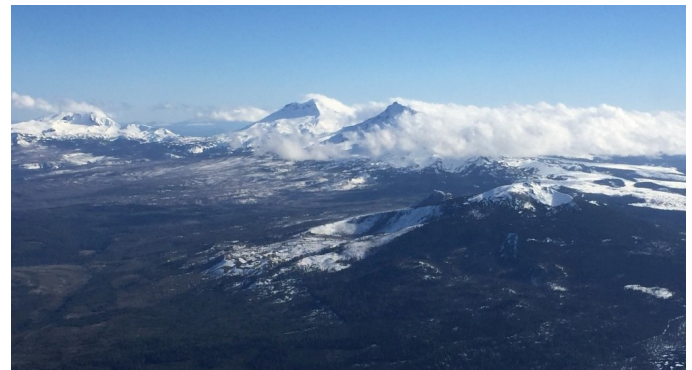
