Message from the (Interim) President





Notes from Members

Not every problem with our airplanes requires a trip to the mechanic...

...sometimes it's possible to do it yourself. Here's a brief story of what happened to me recently when my flying club Cessna 172/November would not start.

I have been flying this airplane quite frequently so I was very surprised recently when I turn the key and the prop would not even turn. I could hear a high-speed spinning sound, but that prop did not even twitch. This airplane is leased so the owner contacted a local mechanic who was too busy to see the airplane but suggested the problem may not be the battery but instead the Bendix. The Bendix is the unit that sits in front of the starter motor and when engaged pushes forward a pinion gear that turns the big gear attached to the driveshaft and turns the propeller.

YouTube offered many useful videos on how a pinion gear operates. Essentially it spins forward on the shaft until it engages the big gear in front. However, because this is directly behind the propeller so it is subject to all the impacts of weather, as well as bugs. The suggestion had been made that the pinion gear was stuck in the rear position and needed to be lubricated so it could spin forward. Specifically, a dry silicone lubricant was required. This is not a WD-40 solution.

I found the correct dry lubricant at Home Depot here in Bend and following suggestions to lubricate the shaft as well as gently tapping the Bendix resulted in success. It took three separate attempts with lubrication and tapping to get the result. That gear was truly stuck.

If you look closely at the first photo below you can see the space between the large gear wheel and the Bendix housing. This is where you use the spray snorkel. After a good spray I tapped the body of the Bendix using a wood dowel and rubber mallet. I've also included a photo of the dry lubricant. I wasn't entirely sure if this was the correct product but a helpful phone call directly to WD-40 indicated this was the proper product.

Naturally if this had not worked after mechanics we would go. But not all problems need that to be the first step and in fact when it's reasonable, try doing it yourself.
