EAA AirVenture 2022 Statistics	
Attendance	2022 – 650,000 2021 – 607,000 2019 – 642,000 (numbers are approximate)
Total Aircraft	> 10,000 at Wittman Regional Airport in Oshkosh and other nearby airports 18,684 aircraft operations in the 11-day period from July 21-31 (average of approximately 121 takeoffs/landings per hour when the airport is open)
Total Showplanes	1,375 registered in vintage aircraft parking 1,156 homebuilt aircraft 369 warbirds 137 ultralights 87 seaplanes 77 aerobatic aircraft <u>25 rotorcraft</u> 3,226 total
Camping	12,000 sites plus drive-in camping accounted for an estimated 40,000 visitors
