PRESIDENT'S CORNER

Safety is no accident. Most people don't like to talk about safety; it's just not macho. I'm reasonable healthy, coordinated, after all I fly aircraft; however, I don't always think about safety. Here is an example. On Tuesday, June 12, I hurried to take a box of YE registration forms out to the car in the garage, but I missed one of the two steps, folded my left leg under me and tore the quadriceps tendon off from my knee cap. This is not a pleasant experience and leads to a lot of thinking "how could this happen" A week later the doctor reattached the tendon and now I "just" have to heal. The six week to six months of healing will give me a lot of time to think and talk about safety; not only in everyday life, but also in flying. As the picture below indicates "Aviation in itself in not inherently dangerous" [but if you don't think actively about safety] "it is terribly unforgiving of any careless, incapacity or neglect". Please take time to discuss and follow safety procedures when you fly, work of just sit. Now go do the safe thing, Dick
