TECH COUNCIL REPORT

Bruce Whitman shared a story of why you shut down an aircraft engine by pulling the mixture to idle cutoff instead of shutting the mags off. With fuel available, a hot engine may continue to fire very roughly and erratically, which can cause the engine to move significantly in it's mounts and cause cowl and other damage (potentially engine mount damage). When you remove the fuel the engine can no longer fire. Also, if unburned fuel is in the cylinders, there is a greater potential for a cylinder to fire while turning the prop over by hand.
