LAST MONTH

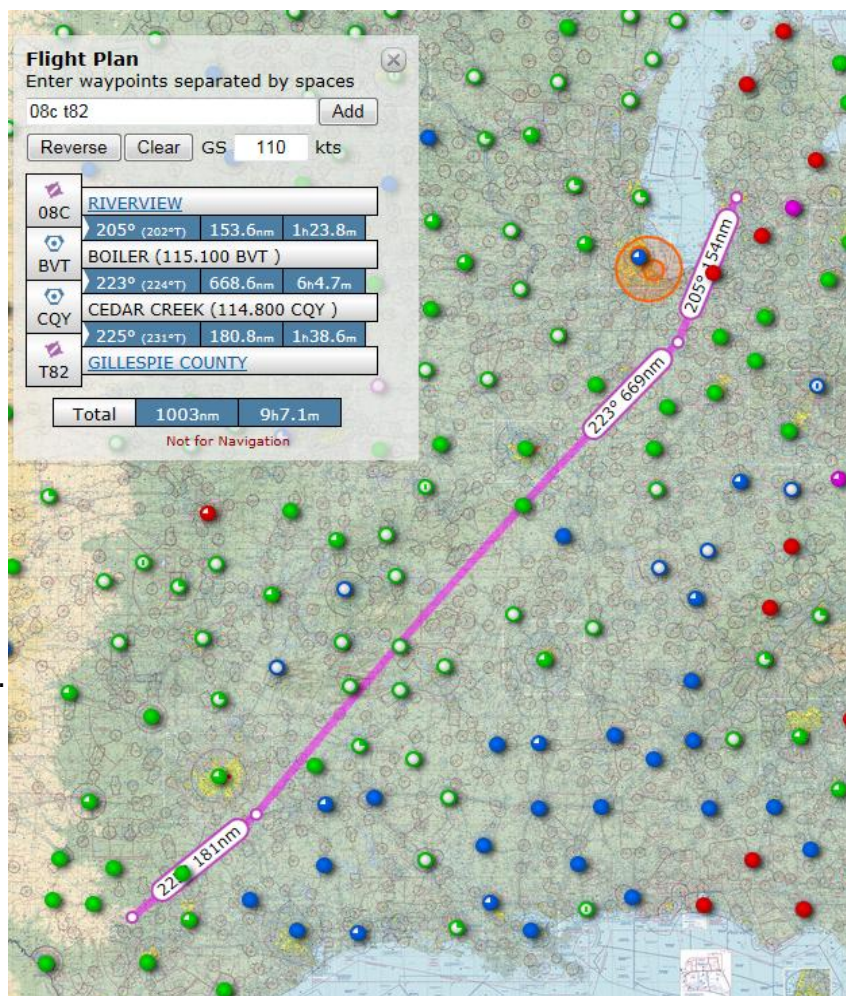

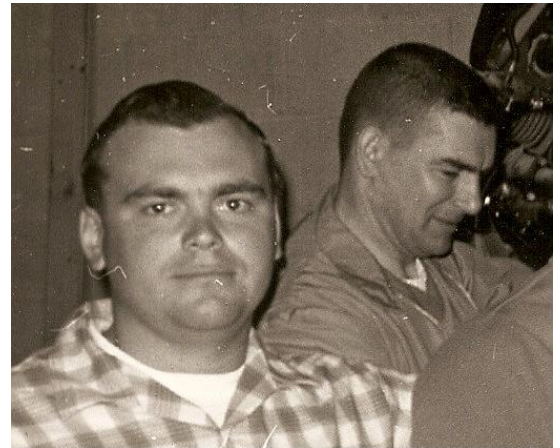
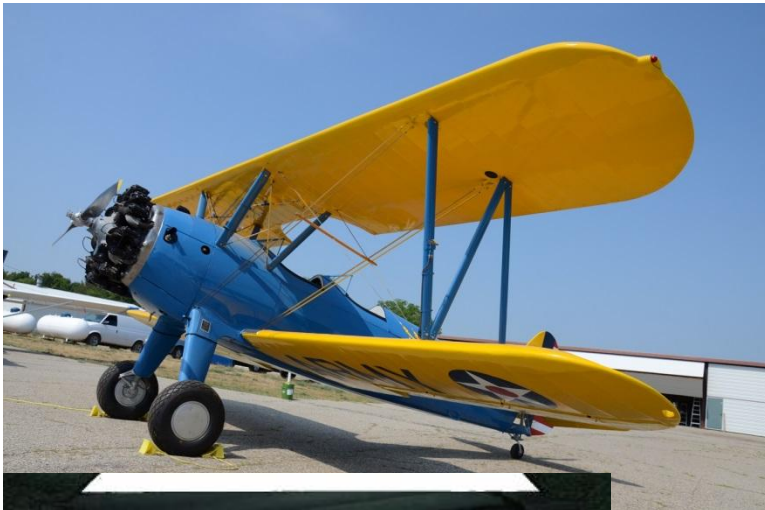


PRESIDENT'S CORNER

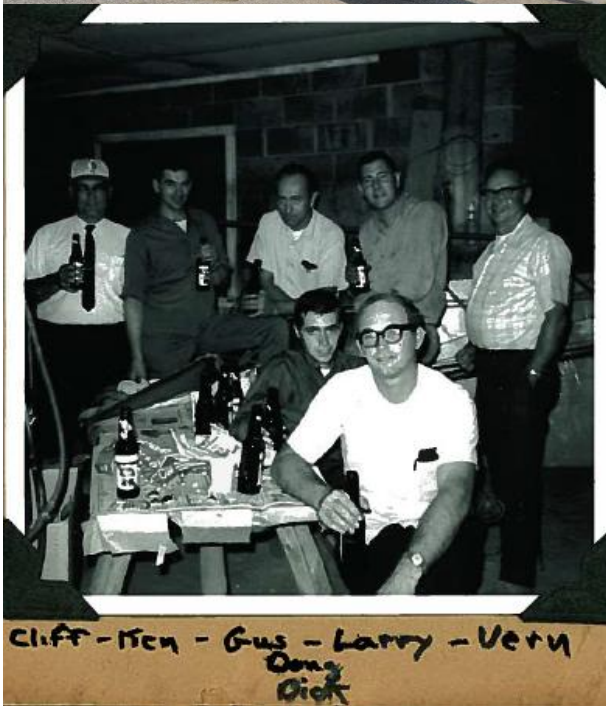
Kenneth Arthur Fryling, 1934-2015

The passing of Ken leaves a void that can only be filled with memories. Fortunately, I have many memories of Ken's activities and will share a few with you.

Ken was one of the early members of EAA145 and served as an officer in EAA145. He also built a Mong Sport experimental aircraft. Ken was active in the early years of establishing Riverview airport and it soon became his second home. I like to think of Ken as the "Mayor" of Riverview.



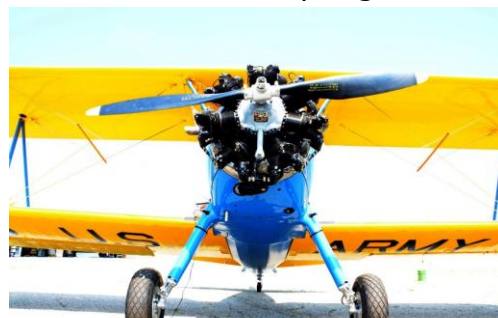

Over the years, Ken supported many of the activities at Riverview. I will relate a memory I have of him at a Young Eagle rally. We were flying Young Eagles out of Gary Kramers hanger, when I had the pilot door pop open in flight. After landing I discovered that the hinge pin had broken. Thinking a new hinge pin would have to be ordered from Cessna, I was about to ground the A/C. Ken came over and asked what was wrong...he then replaced the hinge pin with a piece of thin welding rod and I was back in the air in 10 minuets, flying Young Eagles. The C-172, N12989, still had the welding rod in the hinge when it was scrapped... thanks Ken.

Ken and I were about the same age, so we reminisced about the time we spent in the military. He was in the Air Force and I was in the Army, Special Forces (Airborne)... One thing we had in common was the Fairchild C-119, "Flying Boxcar". He worked on maintaining the C-119 and I jumped out of them. After repairing the C-119 for a while, Ken liked to call them flying Coffins 119. I had to agree with him, that's why I eagerly jumped out of them.

I know many of you have lots of memories of Ken, keep track of them and we will bring those memories to light when Riverview has a celebration of Ken's life later this spring. Here's to the memory of Ken, Pilot, Mechanic, and Friend.

This is a great way to introduce someone to grass roots aviation; invite a friend to go.

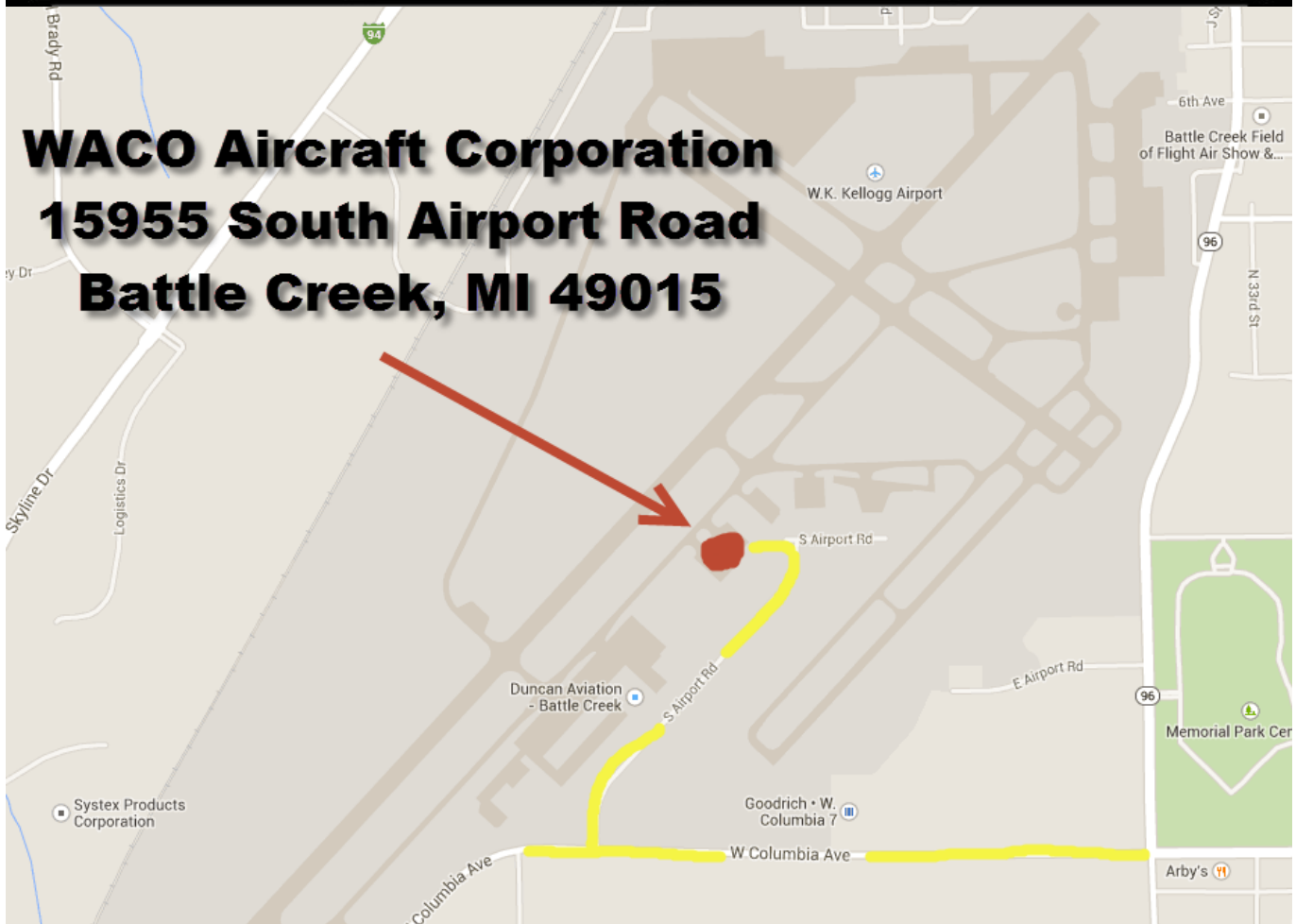

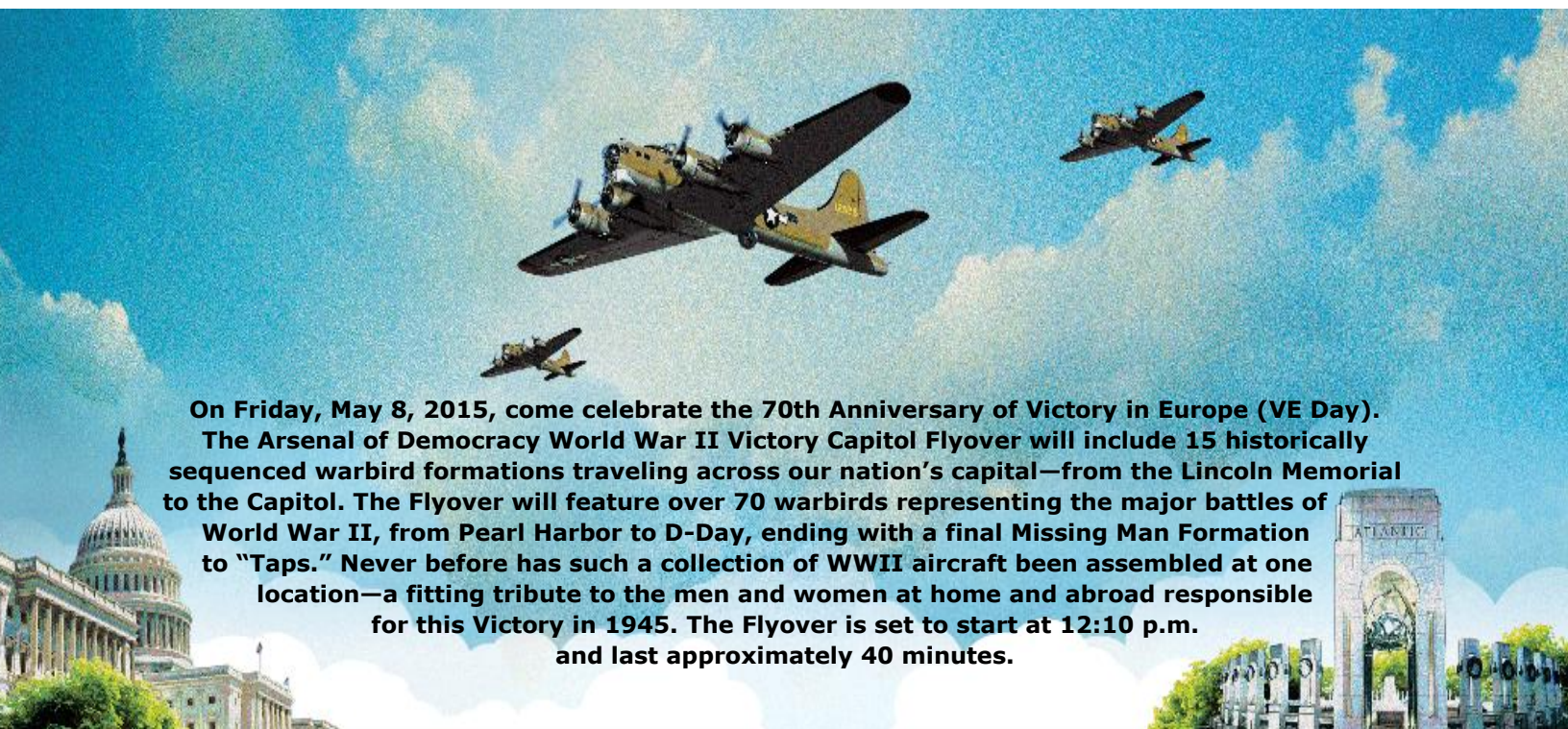

On Friday, May 8, 2015, come celebrate the 70th Anniversary of Victory in Europe (VE Day).

The Arsenal of Democracy World War II Victory Capitol Flyover will include 15 historically sequenced warbird formations traveling across our nation's capital—from the Lincoln Memorial to the Capitol. The Flyover will feature over 70 warbirds representing the major battles of World War II, from Pearl Harbor to D-Day, ending with a final Missing Man Formation to "Taps." Never before has such a collection of WWII aircraft been assembled at one location—a fitting tribute to the men and women at home and abroad responsible for this Victory in 1945. The Flyover is set to start at 12:10 p.m. and last approximately 40 minutes.
