# AirVenture Cup Applications: Available Online, Apply Today

The AirVenture Cup applications have been available for about a month, and so far 25 racers have applied. We are excited that we have quite a few new folks that are going to race with us in addition to many familiar faces that will be coming back again. If you have never raced before, or are a returning AirVenture Cup veteran, this is undoubtedly the fastest and most fun way to get to Oshkosh. We welcome racers from all experience levels. Last year we had a sport pilot with the ink barely dry on their temporary certificate and private pilots to test pilots, airline pilots, and astronauts.

Get your application and required paperwork in as soon as possible. It takes time for EAA to review your documents, and frequently we need to get corrections made to certificates of insurance. The application deadline is July 1, 2015, but we appreciate people getting their paperwork done early.

The application fee is \$275, and for that each race team receives:

- One Adult weekly admission to AirVenture 2015 (An additional wrist band available for an extra fee for crew member)
- The official 2015 AirVenture Cup T-Shirt
- The official 2015 AirVenture Cup Program
- Meals during the pre-race briefing, after arrival at the finish line, and during the awards ceremony, and doughnuts and coffee before race start
- Beverages in Mt. Vernon and Oshkosh
- 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners will receive trophies
