Main Discussion: The reason to get all the West Michigan chapters together is to coordinate events and to open communication between all the chapters. This helps to keep the aviation-minded people close, and not feel isolated. Also, if another chapter has an event, we will not plan an event for Riverview. Multiple events on the same day takes away the amount of folks that will attend our events. Chapter meeting programming was also discussed, and shared with the other chapters so that interesting presenters / programming could be repeated at the neighboring chapter meetings.

The members exchanged contact information, shared dates of various local events, and discussed ideas for future events. Coordination of volunteers and pilots for the Young Eagle events was discussed. Pooling of the Young Eagle credits allows a few kids to be sent to Oshkosh camp at no cost. Kalamazoo & Sparta are having great success with Ray Scholarship award winners.

Special Events with other EAA Chapters: For events with a wide interest (STRATUX DIY ADS-B, Aviation Weather, etc) we will announce this to neighboring EAA chapters.

Camping Flights/Big Tour Flights: The chapter will keep in contact Herb Harney and other area pilots to get trip locations and dates, then pass on information in the newsletter and on the bulletin board.

Chapter Group Flights: Fly outs for the group were discussed. This would allow aircraft with limited size and speed to participate in the group flying activities. Destination examples include Mackinaw Island, Beaver Island, Watervliet camping, Charlevoix, etc.

Oshkosh '22: We started talking about chapter camping at Oshkosh. If there is no interest, we could lose our "legacy" saved spot that has been the home for #145 for so many years. Chapter campsites will be staked out in the order requests are processed. Chapters that wish to sign up for chapter camping must be registered and paid for by June 30, 2022

Activity Planning: Activities for the upcoming year were discussed, among those were Oshkosh Airventure, Young Eagle flights, Eagle flights, Boy Scouts of America Aviation Merit Badge Day, and the October bonfire and Christmas brunch.

2022 Monthly Programs: The chapter tries to bring in interesting presenters and programs. If anyone has ideas for monthly meetings please talk with V.P. Bruce Whitman.

Other: If anyone has ideas / concerns for the chapter, please talk with any chapter officer. This group can excel when everyone contributes. The group allows members to make connections with other aviation minded people, to learn and share knowledge in this technical field, to inspire and be inspired to move ahead with new skills and experiences.


