

Wednesday/Thursday Aug 10 & 11: Initial set up starting with road and street signs. Cleaning and preparing hangar for Friday and Saturday events. Setting up tables and chairs. There may be some guys that can't do Friday so I will have some set up and need help on the Wednesday/Thursday. I will be flexible about time to help so have anyone interested to contact me.

Friday Aug 12: Setup for Tailgate BBQ and Party. This event is open to everyone. We will start the setup on Friday mid-morning. We will need to put up parking barriers for planes and cars. We have some tents that need to go up and a couple exhibits to set up. Make sure all the food and drinks are ready for event by 5 PM, event starts at 6 PM and will continue until dusk. We will have the opportunity to do adult Eagle rides also so if any wants to mentor potential pilots we like to spend about an hour with any adults that are SERIOUS about perusing pilot license. We are not just giving rides but must prequalify these adults. We need pilots with their plane to do these and must meet all EAA requirements. Carbon Cub will be doing some STOL demonstrations also. Food and drinks are provided with donations accepted. We will need some help with clean up also.

Saturday Aug 13: Pancake Breakfast - starts at 8 AM. We will start setting up and preparing for the breakfast at 6:30 AM. EAA145 HISTORY, 60 YEARS AGO

Harry F. Wells, 1921-2015. Co-founder of EAA 145 in 1962:

A Detroit newspaper photo showed a sad young Harry with his damaged model plane. Alongside his high school yearbook (1939) photo was "Lindbergh and me."

He enlisted in the Army Air Corps, went to Officer Candidate School, and became a navigator in a B-24. He credited the Tuskegee Airmen with escorting his B-24 and crew back to base in Italy for his surviving WWII. He was called back for the Korean War, had his birthday on both sides of the International Date Line.

He used the GI-Bill to get a pilot's license, became an instructor, bought 40 acres and developed a grass strip into Wells Airport, which survives 3 miles east of Rockford. He flew wife, 4 small children and two Chihuahuas in a Waco QDC to Florida in the 1960s. He last owned an Aeronca Chief, Stinson and a Staggerwing Beech.

Deafness ultimately caused a loss of balance, a fall and a head injury fall in 1998 so he never flew again. He died at age 93 in the VA Facility in Augusta GA.


