- · Built in Chicago by the Howard Aircraft Company in 1939. The sales price was about \$16,500 so was favored by wealthy businessmen and celebrities.
- · At one time, it was owned by the Halliburton Oil Company and is now owned by the Howard Aircraft Foundation.
- Only 4 DGA-11s were produced and this is the only survivor. The design was a direct development of the famous Howard racing plane Mister Mulligan (DGA-6).
 Designer/pilot Ben Howard's "DGA" prefix stands for "Damned Good Airplane".
