EAA Aviation Museum Joins Blue Star Museum Program for 2022

The EAA Aviation Museum is participating in the annual Blue Star Museums program, a collaboration among the National Endowment for the Arts, Blue Star Families, the Department of Defense, and museums across America to offer free admission to the nation's active-duty military personnel and their families this summer.

The EAA museum is one of numerous Wisconsin museums involved in Blue Star Museums supporting the program. A list of the more than 2,000 participating museums nationwide is available at https://www.arts.gov/initiatives/blue-star-museums.

"EAA wanted to be involved in this program to say thanks to those men and women currently serving our country in the armed services, and to their immediate families who sacrifice so much to support them," said Ron Connolly, EAA Aviation Museum director.

The 2022 free museum admission offer is good from Armed Forces Day (May 21) through Labor Day (September 5). It is not valid during EAA AirVenture Oshkosh week (July 23-31).

The free admission program is available for those currently serving in the United States Military — Army, Navy, Air Force, Marine Corps, Coast Guard as well as members of the Reserves, National Guard, U.S. Public Health Commissioned Corps, NOAA Commissioned Corps — and up to five family members. Qualified members must show a Geneva Convention common access card (CAC), DD Form 1173 ID card (dependent ID), or a DD Form 1173-1 ID card for entrance into a participating Blue Star Museum.

New Location, New Format for Pilot Proficiency Center at AirVenture 2022

The popular Pilot Proficiency Center programs during EAA AirVenture Oshkosh, where pilots can improve their decision-making and flying skills, will be one of the first major events in the new Pilot Proficiency Center located adjacent to the EAA Aviation Museum. The programs,

which are free of charge, had previously been located in a tent pavilion on the Four Corners on the AirVenture grounds.

"This new location offers pilots expanded opportunities to do deep-dives on scenarios and subjects that will make them better aviators, led by some of the leading instructors in the nation," said Jeremy Desruisseaux, EAA's director of flight proficiency. "The new facilities in the EAA Aviation Center also give participants a top-notch location that is a year-round presence, allowing for enhanced experiences for those who are a part of this valuable program."

This year's expanded schedule gives participants the opportunity for three breakout sessions in numerous categories during half-day clinics. Those categories include:

Killer Procedures Learn-to-Turn
 Backcountry Awareness The Art of IFR

CFI-to-CFI Stick & Rudder Redux

• The Amateur-Built Flight Test Experience

Complete schedules of topics and speakers will be available in the coming days. Participants are reminded that the half-day sessions will be held at the EAA Aviation Center, and preregistration is required. Walk-in slots will only be made available if unfilled slots remain after pre-registration. Further details will be announced when registration officially opens. The AirVenture 2022 Pilot Proficiency Center is supported by Hartzell Propeller, Hartzell Engine Technologies, and NATCA. Simulators are sponsored by Redbird Flight Simulators, with Tech Talks sponsored by The Boeing Company. BOSE Aviation supplies the official headset of the EAA Pilot Proficiency Center.

EAA Chapter 540, Smoketown, PA (S37)

EAA Chapter 540 had its beginnings almost five decades ago (1974), in the small town of Smoketown, PA. Like many chapters of that time, a bunch of guys got together and started their chapter out of their love of flying and their desire to build their own airplanes. While there were initial efforts for the chapter to have their own hanger, it never materialized. The chapter members built their airplane projects in their own small hangers, garages, barns and basements and visited each other to see the progression of their projects. Members held Fly-in events to raise money and had occasional get-togethers and the chapter successfully functioned. Smoketown Airport built several hangers over the years, but the smaller hangers were too small for the chapter to do any serious building and the larger hangers were quickly rented out (on an almost permanent basis in some cases), which left little opportunity for the chapter to have its own hanger. On a side note, Smoketown doesn't sell their hangers to anyone, they're rented only. While the Chapter longed for a "home," the larger hangers simply weren't available or were cost prohibitive for the Chapter to rent when they did become available.

Recently however, that all changed. A longtime renter of a larger hanger (over four decades) who is also a longtime Chapter member (also over four decades), agreed to rent us most of his hanger space at a reasonable rental rate. The Chapter is currently in the process of hanging EAA 540 Chapter banners outside, cleaning out the hanger, building large work benches and getting ready for the next phase of our journey.

We are recruiting some of our current members to share their plane building skills to the lesser skilled members and intend to have a "basic sheet metal working" session(s) very soon. Within the next few months, we will begin building our first project as a group. Equally as important, however, is that we now have a place to call our own where we can meet, socialize, teach, learn, and promote airplane building and flying. Additionally, we will be having several open houses this year to promote and grow the Chapter.

Chapter 540 is seeking donations in the form of airplane projects, tools, and other related items to get the ball rolling. While we are currently a small chapter, we expect to change that by marketing and promoting our chapter.


