EAA AirVenture Safety Protocols Last updated May 28, 2021.

- EAA members now have the option to receive admissions credentials including wristbands in advance through our Express Arrival program. This is offered at no extra charge when you purchase your tickets online and eliminates the need to go to an admissions building.
- If you are not fully vaccinated, masks will be recommended if you are unable to social distance (roughly 6 feet or 2 meters).
- Proof of COVID vaccine will not be required to attend.
- International visitation is dependent on current international travel regulations and mandates in the U.S. and individual countries of residence.
- Increased physical distancing will be encouraged in all areas.
- EAA is adding significant numbers of sanitizing facilities and working with industry-leading companies for continual disinfection throughout the grounds.
- Theater in the Woods, forums pavilions, and other outdoor venues will operate with reduced seating capacity, with social distancing opportunities on the open grounds at that location.
- There will be fewer exhibitors in each indoor exhibit building, creating more walkways and separation between exhibitors. Additional venues on the grounds are being re-purposed to accommodate indoor exhibitors that are moved this year.
- Wherever possible, ventilation will be increased in tents and indoor facilities.
- Several annual events where physical distancing is not possible will not be held this year, including the Monday night concert; the EAA Lifetime Member Dinner, International Visitors Dinner, and Young Eagles Volunteer Award Dinner; the Runway 5K run/walk; the WomenVenture social; the Seaplane Base's Watermelon social, and large corporate events and receptions.
- High-demand forums and presentations will be scheduled more than once to accommodate demand while allowing for distancing.

Thus, with sincere applause, we congratulate the Zanesville Municipal Airport on its Seventy-fifth Anniversary and extend best wishes for ongoing success.






EAA Vintage Chapter 22



Upcoming Missions, Developments, and More!

Astronaut Kayla Barron Added to SpaceX Crew-3 Mission by NASA



It will be three female astronauts in a row flying on a SpaceX Dragon to the International Space Station. NASA made it official that rookie astronaut Kayla Barron will be a mission specialist on the Crew-3 mission. Barron follows NASA astronauts Shannon Walker and Megan McArthur who are part of Crew-1 and Crew-2, respectively. Barron, who was selected as an astronaut in 2017, will join NASA astronauts Raja Chari and Tom Marshburn, the mission's commander and pilot, and European Astronaut Matthias Maurer who will also serve as a mission specialist.

Crew-3 is targeted to launch on October 23 from Kennedy Space

Center in Florida. Barron has a bachelor's degree in systems engineering from the U.S. Naval Academy and a master's degree in nuclear engineering from the University of Cambridge in

England. Lt. Commander Barron earned her submarine warfare officer qualification and deployed three times while serving aboard

the USS Maine. This will also be the first spaceflights for Chari and Maurer and the third spaceflight for Marshburn.

Mask Mandate Update! If you are fully vaccinated (meaning it is two weeks past your final dose) you no longer need to wear a mask at the National Museum of the U.S. Air Force™!

Those who are not fully vaccinated must continue to wear masks inside the museum.

Harbor Springs, Harbor Springs, MI (MGN)

Nice little airport in northern Michigan on Little Traverse Bay. A courtesy car is available although we brought our folding bikes because we heard there was a trail which ran from Harbor Springs through Petoskey to Charlevoix, an area known as Michigan's Gold Coast.

The bike trail is a former railroad track which mostly follows the shoreline of the Little Traverse Bay and runs past the approach end of runway 28. The trail is a wide, paved, landscaped path with only slight slopes, and has many scenic lookouts and parks along the way.

There is easy access to downtown shopping and restaurants from the trail. Bed and breakfasts and hotels from the quaint to the elaborate can be found along the path as well as a couple of campgrounds, one of which is located in Petoskey State Park.. There is also a place right on the trail which rents bikes if you don't have your own to bring.



Coles County Memorial Airport, Matoon, IL (MTO)

Airport Steakhouse on field. Great food and excellent breakfasts.



Capri Drive-in Theater, Coldwater, MI (KOEB)

Capri Drive-In Theater is a cool old outdoor movie theater right next to the airport that you can taxi up to within a 5 minute walk. Fly in for the movie and camp overnight and have breakfast at the Prop Blast Cafe there on the grounds.

Messenger Lake is across the road part of the famous Chain of Lakes and offers dockside float plane fuel.

There's also a courtesy car at the FBO's hangar to get to nearby hotels and cabins



Mackinac Island Airport, Mackinac Island, MI (MCD)

If you fly in no where else in Michigan, this is the one place you have to go! We take friends and family several times per year. The airport is about a mile walk into town through the woods on paved roads, though there are no cars on the island!

Just horse drawn wagons and buggies. Yes, very touristy, but very unique and well worth spending a day walking, hiking, renting bikes, eating, shopping, taking in wonderful views! No fuel at this state-run airport, but the airport office/terminal is new and first class.

Eat at Millie's on Main if you want to go where the local's eat. Good food at fair prices

So Metettal airport is one of the few places that you still can land for some variety of food, enjoy a walk and some other activities. Happy landing.


