Dave Dent presented a program on Burt Rutan's Boomerang – the odd twin engine aircraft



For those that don't know Dave worked on the Engine Systems on the design and has worked with Burt Rutan both before and after the Boomerang project. From my engineering background it was interesting to hear the development challenges of the project. After the first flight ended up with a wrecked airplane in a cloud of dust between the runway and the taxiway, Burt was ready to scrap the project. I am not sure how many of us have seen this plane in person.


The other interesting part for me was finding out that Burt built the Boomerang with a tight budget. It is easy to think of someone who has contributed so much to aviation has unlimited resources. To find out that they are making incredible contributions while also working on a shoestring budget is incredible.

# **EAA National survey on Covid from August 2020:**

Sandy Walther requested info from EAA National to find out if they knew how other EAA chapters were operating during this pandemic. Charlie Becker said he had conducted a survey of chapter presidents a couple months ago, and he shared the attached results.

EAA National surveyed local EAA chapters across the US to find out how the coronavirus was impacting their operations. Out of 383 chapters surveyed, they found 37% were holding in-person membership meetings, 20% were meeting virtually, 14% were hybrid (both virtual and in-person) and 29% have not had any meetings. When asked if the chapter was planning to renew in 2021, 77.5% answered definitely Yes, 1.5% definitely No and the remaining 21% were unsure. At the time of the survey, many of the chapters had scheduled events through the remainder of 2020. Over 73% were planning member gatherings, 65% were holding board meetings, 21% were planning a Young Eagle rally or build event, 15% were holding public events (like a pancake breakfast), and 20% had no events or meetings planned.

EAA Chapter 172 is fortunate to be located in a region that is allowing public gatherings. In our own survey a few months ago, most of our members indicated they would rather meet in person rather than virtually. As a result, we began holding inperson chapter meetings again in October. We are following official health guidance such as social distancing, wearing masks when social distancing is not practical, and avoiding buffet food situations. Attendance at our past two chapter meetings has been sparse, however.

#### WHERE TO FIND US:

EAA172 meets every 2<sup>nd</sup> Saturday of the month at several locations around Augusta, GA throughout the year. However, our primary meeting place is at our chapter clubhouse on Pea Patch Aerodrome (61GA) in Blythe, GA. Take Route 1 toward Blythe, turn south at the Citgo/Quik Mart station onto Bath-Edie Road. At the first intersection, turn right onto Patterson Road and follow ½ mile. Make a left turn onto Boulineau Road (across from the Rec Center) and drive 1 mile. The entrance to Pea Patch is on your right. The clubhouse is at the end of a row of hangars next to the grass strip, just south of the windsock.
