#### Chapter 18 Minutes from the August "2016" Meeting

This time the Young Eagle pilots must have completed the **EAA Youth Protection Policy on-line course** as well as the usual currency requirements. (Medical. Flt Review, Current on takeoffs and landing and be a member of EAA. Airplanes need to be legal with annual inspection, pitot/static check, transponder and ELT checked if equipped.
