Old man winter not wanting to leave

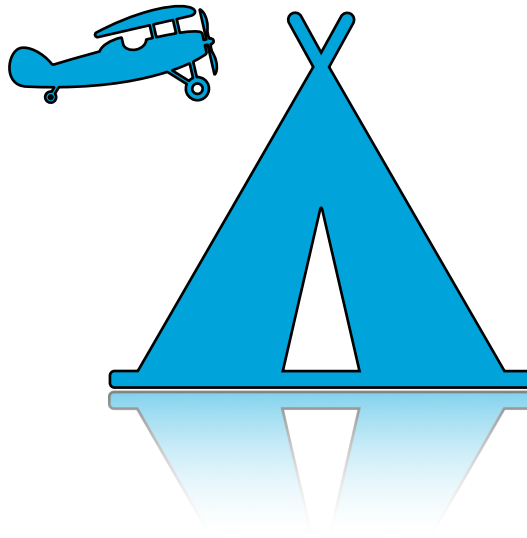

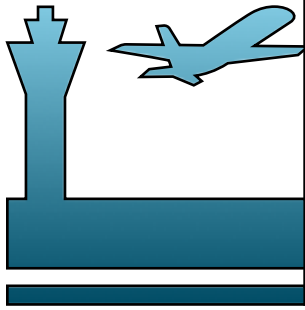
