- (for Advanced Camp, Session 2)
- Provide for some personal expenses (see Note below)
- Write a follow-up report
- Attend EAA Ch 228 meeting on August 25, 2020 at the Commemorative Air Force hangar at Falcon Field airport (corner of Greenfield and McKellips Rds) and speak about your experiences at the Air Academy
 - * Your Letter of Application should include a paragraph for each of the following questions:
- Why you want to attend the EAA Air Academy?
- What aviation experiences, education, or training you have to date?
- What aviation experiences would you like to gain from your EAA Air Academy experience?
- What aviation related career goals do you have that could be further advanced from your experiences at the EAA Air Academy?

Note: This Scholarship is for the Air Academy Advance camp tuition only. It does not include the cost of transportation to and from Oshkosh.

The Application, Letter of Application and Letters of Reference (4 items) need to be mailed to me, POSTMARKED between January 2-24, 2020.
