Sometimes we all UNDERESTIMATE the DEGREE to which our STATE of MIND can affect our NORMALLY FOCUSED attention to the DETAILS of SAFE FLYING. PLEASE TRY to regularly SELF EVALUATE PRIOR to flight. Not just physically but MENTALLY AS WELL. When we're DISTRACTED. We perhaps SHOULD NOT be FLYING. NUFF SAID.


