N23SR flies!

On June 10, 2017, I made my first flight in RV-8 S/N 83041, N23SR—spent about 30 minutes aloft. What an amazing aircraft—flew straight and true. There were a few minor calibrations that needed to be addressed regarding some Dynon settings, but other than that I could not have been more pleased. Being a new "tail wheel" pilot, I was a bit anxious when it came time to land, but the landing proved uneventful. I now have nearly 10 hours on the plane and nothing has fallen off to date!

My plane is equipped with a 10" Dynon Skyview Touch, autopilot, Garmin GTN650, ICOM210, Garmin GMA240 and a Vertical Power VP-X (this greatly simplified the wiring process). My engine is a Lycoming IO-360-M1B 180 hp driving a 72" Hartzell C/S prop. What a performer! I also have the Grove airfoiled landing gear. The total build time was 2600+hours over 7 years and 4 months. I still need to finish the wheel pants, but I'm not in a big rush for more fiberglass work!




John Halterman is now an Aeronaut!

I spent the last first 2 weeks of July in Albuquerque and received my pilot license on July 15th for piloting Lighter Than Air—Balloons w/ Airborne Heater. It was a very challenging experience, and it only has 2 controls: heat and vent (up and down). It was a great experience. (FYI—no, I don't own a balloon, nor, have one on order.)

Attached are a few pictures. The one with the plethora of balloons was a big liftoff done on Sunday July 9 from the same field where balloon fiesta occurs annually. It was with about 50 other balloonists (technically, aeronauts) in the Albuquerque area. The one over the river is during training (Rio Grande). The other are photos from my checkride, with the examiner saying "it's clearly a pass ©". The landing was a "rip-out landing" with about a 300-400 feet per minute descent rate due to obstacles and about a 10-12 mph wind. That's relatively fast for a balloon. However, we walked away and the examiner was very pleased with it.
