Charlie has re-installed his overhauled propeller on his RV-7. New propeller blades were installed in his overhauled hub and completed his 500 hr magneto inspection.

Mark's Super Cub repair continues. Engine Overhaul is on schedule with Pine Mountain Aviation. A new propeller 48-inch pitch is on order from Sensenich. Cowling and gear parts are slow to arrive from Univair. F. Atlee Dodge has a Piper Filler Neck repair kit to replace the leaking filler necks that have failed welds. 
David Buyak's Cessna 172 rebuild continues having completed his first engine run since engine overhaul with only a few bugs that were easily corrected.
