



EAA HANGAR DOOR INSTALLATION IS PROGRESSING

The EAA hangar door installation is progressing very nicely. At this point, the old sheet steel and door tracks have been removed, the door has been raised, leveled, anchored to the existing header framework, bolted to the header framework, and the side rail J-Channel's have been installed. In addition, all eleven original roof trusses have been braced back to the header. Door latch mechanisms, the electrical installation and the insulation and outer sheathing is being worked on today (Sunday). All EAA volunteers are welcome to help with this project.
