### FABRIC COVERING WORKSHOP


Starting this month, when the business portion of the meeting has been completed, we will be starting a "hands-on" workshop on fabric covering using the Poly-Fiber System (formerly Stits).

Thanks to Rodney, Greg, Yan and a few other volunteers, a small aluminum airfoil was fabricated to be used as a training "buck" for conducting fabric workshops. If this training piece works well for us, we will fabricate more units so we can conduct larger training workshops.

During our first evening, we will be discussing the preparations steps to covering, installing anti-chafe tape, glueing the fabric in-place, heat forming the fabric around the ends of the piece and heat shrinking the fabric. Illustrations of the airfoil can be viewed on the next page
