As of last Sunday, we have launched our 2023 fundraising project for the chapter. After a quick road trip to Houghton Lake, MI, we were able to pick up an 1946 Taylorcraft BC12D project. Much thanks to David Keller, Nancy Springar for supplying a 28' enclosed trailer to transport the bird. In addition David and Nick Yegge, Jon Harris and David Hubbard served as the Retrival Team.

The "Team" was able to unload the hangar in Houghton Lake in about an hour and one half. The load was safely transported back to Brighton and was unloaded into the EAA hangar on last Tuesday. Greg Pawczuk and Ron Stonewall also helped on the unloading end.

The project included a good looking Taylorcraft fuselage, multiple tail feathers, wings and extra spar material and even two engines.
