



FABRIC WORKSHOP CONTINUED

we will continue the fabric covering workshop this month, after the business portion of the meeting has been completed.


Last month, David Yegge, Dan Smokovicz and Rod Beckwith were our volunteers. We were able to heatform the material around the ends of the airfoil and Poly-Tak the fabric down on the ends. We aslo preshrunk two end cap doilies to cover the material on the ends that were tacked down. Finally, the volunteers were able to heat shrink the dacron at the 250°F temp and the final 350°F.

This month, we will look for two new volunteers to pink-up the surface of the airfoil, install the reinforcing tape, mark out, and chalk-line both sides of the airfoil with the appropriate spacing distances and begin the rib laceing process.

This is a "hands-on" workshop so come on out and have some fun with the covering process.

At the April meeting, we will be installing the finishing tapes.
