Young Eagles

Chapter 402 has Young Eagles Rallies scheduled for June 8th (IYED) and September 14th. The first event is already up on the YEDAY.org website for volunteer pilots and ground volunteers to sign up and will be open for kids to register from May 19th at 1 AM until June 7th at 6 PM. The initial planning allows for 60 kids to be flown over the 3 1/2 hours of the morning, June 8th. To fly 60 kids we need a minimum of 3 three-seat planes constantly moving. It would be better to have more planes. Very importantly, In addition to pilots we also need 10-12 ground volunteers during the event to keep things moving and to ensure safety.

The requirements to be a Young Eagles Pilot are the following:

- Be a current EAA member and hold a Sport pilot or greater airman's certificate.
- Have a current medical certificate or Basic Med (if applicable).
- Be current to carry passengers in the aircraft being flown for YE.
- Have a current flight review.
- Conduct YE flights in an airworthy aircraft.
- Have a minimum of \$100,000 per seat passenger liability for the aircraft used (owned, rented or borrowed).
- Adhere to all Federal Aviation Regulations.
- Have completed EAA's Youth Protection Program (YPP) training and background check. (In your browser search for EAA.ORG/YPP). Ground vols should do this too.
- Complete the YE registration form and waiver before each flight. This is done at the registration table during the event.

Pilots and ground volunteers are encouraged to go to the YEDAY.org website, choose the June 8th VTA event and click "Sign Up," fill out the form and submit it. The YEDAY program will automatically keep me, the chapter YE coordinator informed. With questions or if you encounter difficulties please call me at 740-323-6994. Thank you.

- Sam reported that the Zenith Control Surfaces are complete and progress is being made in other areas. He reports that Leota is "Still Polishing" the Project C150.
- Steve reported that he still has two spots available in the RV for passengers, first-come first-served.
- Dave (Holsinger) reported that the Leading edge of his wings were showing themselves to be rather
 problematic and that a special tool (unavailable) was needed to do it right and easily. A 4' 3" section is
 needed as well as the aileron.
