Treasurer's Report

This is a summary of the monthly report dated June 16, 2020 from Treasurer, Melissa Quitter. The starting balance was \$2962.47. Dues paid: \$90.00. Donations to Utility Fund: \$37.00. Miscellaneous Receipts: \$4000.00 (from EAA for Ray Aviation Scholarship). Expenses for Utilities: \$81.97. FEEs and charges: \$11.00. YE Expense \$0.00. Ending balance was \$6,996.50 including \$4000 for Ray Aviation scholarship and \$1649.24 in YE fund. Outstanding receipts: YE credits \$370.00.

Airport Board

Reported by Bill Corban. Of general interest, the Board meeting included discussion of a new terminal building, and the possibility of moving or replacing the maintenance and west hangars, all of course due to the relocated taxiway. Additionally, our outgoing engineer presented findings regarding the cost overruns on the taxiway project and engineering information regarding the drainage problem which became apparent after the recent 100+ year rain event. The new engineers presented information on estimates of the range of expenses for various airport improvements under consideration.
