#### **Gaines Valley Aviation Honors Earl Luce**

On October 26, 2023, Gaines Valley Aviation (GVA), held a ceremony to honor the late Earl J Luce, Jr., by dedicating and naming the air field, NY06, after him. GVA President Raymond Johnson conducted the ceremony, wherein an few anecdotes about Earl were shared, relating to his love of aviation, and hunting. There were about 40 people in attendance, including several members of EAA 44.

GVA President Raymond Johnson answered a question as to whether the name of the airport would be changed on sectional charts with the response that the paperwork with the FAA was a huge hassle, and that it will remain as Gaines Valley on them, but local air traffic will likely refer to it as Luce Field.


