### **Poplar Grove Visit**

Prior to the regular chapter meeting nine chapter members, plus two family members, visited the Poplar Grove Aviation Education Association (PGAEA) where a 1930s designed 'Curtis Jenny' is being built, from scratch, using original manufacturer's drawings, by a team of dedicated enthusiasts and experts. The visitors were given an excellent overview of the history of the aircraft, its service life application together with an extremely fine detailed description of the original and current build techniques. 'Close up' access to the aircraft was permitted with a 'hands off' caveat to protect the machine from inadvertent harm. Every question was answered comprehensively and with delightful enthusiasm from our presenter. At the conclusion of the presentation chapters members gratefully made an individual contribution to the project accompanied by a similar contribution from chapter funds. In summary, it was a fascinating and enlightening experience to observe an old classic bi-plane being built, using some modern processes, but still observing the original techniques utilized 90 odd years ago. Special thanks were extended to our presenter and our co-coordinator/enabler for the visit.
