### **MILESTONE FLIGHT CONGRATULATIONS STAN!**


On a rotten blustery day a few weeks ago, Stan Z. made his first solo flight! He has been working all Summer with Cade and Dave T on his glider rating.



# INSTRUCTION IN EXPERIMENTAL CATEGORY A/C - LODA

Those of you with experimental category aircraft should be familiar with the recent Federal court judgment that makes it illegal to receive instruction in an experimental category aircraft. This problem was not caused by the FAA but rather by the federal Judiciary System and the FAA was very quick to come up with a workaround for this problem. Experimental aircraft owners must apply for and receive a Letter of Deviation Authority -LODA - or work with an instructor who has a blanket LODA. The process for acquiring this LODA is identical for the aircraft or the instructor. Use the following link to apply for your LODA:
