I got to meet with legendary test pilot and air racer TONY LEVIER several times. He inspired me to want to learn to fly when he told me, "you haven't lived until you've soloed". He was a remarkably energetic man in his 80's then and was a real living history of aviation.

The video below illustrates his flying ability and keen sense of humor. Lockheed also made a promo film about the P38 and I spent an evening in a Burbank hanger with the P38 then known as White Lightning, owned and flown by Lefty Gardner. It is now the polished beauty owned and flown by REDBULL.
